NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC rules and regulations including, but not limited to, the following:

- This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Agility
 Association of Canada (AAC). The obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the
 current edition of the AAC Official Rules and Regulations and shall conform to AAC
 specifications.
- All breeds and mixed breeds 18 months of age and older (no exceptions) are eligible to compete. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs are ineligible as are bitches in season, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance (judge's discretion).
- All dogs must have an AAC Registration Number before their entries will be accepted in an AAC sanctioned trial. The registration form is available at www.aac.ca.
- Dogs with numbers pending will not be eligible to compete.
- No toys, food, or other training devices shall be allowed in the ring.
- We request no squeaky toys around the immediate perimeter of the ring.
- All dogs must be under control (i.e. penned, crated, or leashed) when not in the ring.
 Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or
 children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour
 may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds
 for entries if the dog or handler is dismissed from the competition for any reason.
- Manual timing will be used at the trial.

ENTRIES

- Anyone not in good standing with AAC will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Cheques can be made payable to Dianne Ford and dated no later than the closing date (April 15, 2018). Alternatively, entry fees may be paid through electronic transfer to Dianne@DPFLeadingAgility.com. Entries, including completed Entry Form and fees, must be received by the closing date.
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations after the closing date except for bitches in season or injury to a dog (veterinarian certificate required) or handler, which physically prevents them from competing. Refunds requested for any other reason will be handled on a case-by-case basis and will be at the discretion of Dianne Ford.
- There is a \$50 administration fee for all NSF cheques.
- By AAC rules, entries are not valid until payment of entry fees has been received or confirmed.
- Regionals: the regional qualifier for Nationals is open to Regular, Specials, and Veterans dogs. No Q's are available for Regionals (clean runs do not count towards titles). All dogs must enter and run 2 Standards, 2 Jumpers, and 2 Gamblers courses.

AAC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Regular: Dogs will jump standard heights and course times as set by AAC rules.

Specials: Open to all dogs. Course times and jump heights as set by AAC rules.

Veterans: For dogs 7 years of age or older in the case of dogs who have been competing in

Regular classes, and for dogs 5 years of age or older who have been competing in the Specials division for a minimum of one year. Once a dog has entered an official trial in the Veterans division, they may no longer compete in the Regular or Specials

divisions. Course times and jump heights as set by AAC rules.

Double Drop For those dogs that are in the veterans class jumping 2 heights below their Regular

Veterans: height.

JUNIOR HANDLERS

• Junior Handlers must have their own AAC Junior Handler ID.

- A handler entered in the junior class may not compete in regular classes (including games) at the same AAC trial.
- It is the responsibility of the Junior Handler/Guardian to be aware of the AAC rules pertaining to AAC's Junior Handler Program.

DIRECTIONS



- 1. Exit Airport via World Drive towards Navigator Avenue (Holiday Inn Express)
- 2. After round-about, at lights, turn left onto Portugal Cove Road, NL40 South
- 3. After 1.6 km, take ramp right to Trans Canada Hwy, NL1 West
- 4. Stay on NL1 West for 14.5 kms to Exit 41B toward St. John's/Mount Pearl
- 5. Take exit ramp to NL2 East
- 6. After 3.8 kms, take exit ramp on right to Mount Pearl/Goulds/Ruby Line
- 7. Turn right at bottom of ramp onto Southlands Blvd.
- 8. After 250 meters, take first right onto Treetop Drive
- 9. Take first left (still Treetop Drive), entry to park is on your left, just below Cottonwood Crescent
- 10. Park near the mailboxes (situated before the houses), and walk on the grass alley/path to ball park.

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host business has the right to refuse my entry for causes which DPF Leading Agility and the proprietor shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate: I/We agree to hold DPF Leading Agility, Dianne Ford (the organizer and host organization which it represents including its owner), Agility Association of Canada, owners of the premises upon which the event is being held, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
