PLEASE NOTE

All dogs competing must be registered with AAC and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. *If your dog does not have an AAC registration number, please complete the registration form provided on the AAC website at www.aac.ca.*

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's AAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it. Also, please check the copy of the results posted after the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

When not competing, dogs must be penned, crated, or leashed. Dogs must be under control at all times when entering and exiting the trial ring and warm-up areas. Exhibitors are required to supply their own chairs, crates/pens for benching. Exhibitors must keep benching and exercise areas clean. Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Anyone who does not do this may be excused from the trial by the Trial Committee.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event (Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc.) has the right to refuse this entry for any reason which the organizing committee deems sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the holding of the event and of the opportunity to have this dog participate to be judged, I (we) agree as follows:

1. While at or in proximity to this event to freely assume all risk of loss (including death) or damage or injury, collectively called "Loss" to myself, this dog or any dog under my control and to members of my family, my guests and to our property;
2. To release and discharge and to hold harmless and indemnify the organizing committee, the club and its directors, officers and members, the sanctioning body for the event (The Agility Association of Canada), sponsors of the event, and the owners of the premises or grounds upon which this event is held, and their respective employees and agents, collectively called the "Releasees" of and from any and all claims, and from all liability of any nature, for all Loss which I or this dog or any dog under my control or members of my family or my guests or our property may suffer for any reason or cause whatsoever, including specifically, but without limitation, all

Loss resulting from the action or inaction of any dog, including this dog, or its owner or handler, or by the Releasees, or any of them, whether through negligence or otherwise. I expressly assume the risk and liability for all such Loss while attending or in proximity to this event and waive any and all claims relating thereto;
