Basic Conduct for Drop-Ins:

- 1) You use it, you help put it away. We can't guarantee others will be present during drop-in times, so use what you can safely take out and put away. If you notice equipment getting worn out and if it looks unsafe, please don't use it, and be sure to inform a Board member so it can be repaired.
- 2) Respect that other dogs might not like to socialize or have other dogs in their face. Drop-ins are not a play time between dogs as it can be unsafe for dogs to run around and play with each other around the equipment. If you do not know a dog at the drop-in, introduce yourself to the handler. If you have a dog who has quirks, please inform others so they may be aware and handle their dog accordingly.
- 3) Feel free to offer assistance to each other and give each other ideas. This is a non-instructional time, so the onus is on the members to make of the hour. A great way is for those who show up, invent a little practice exercise and then everyone share the exercise/set-up.

General Agreement: I agree that NADA has the right to refuse this registration application for cause, which NADA shall deem to be sufficient. I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and same the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
