## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors through the entry of this trial entry form, acknowledge they are aware of the current Agility Association of Canada (AAC) Official Rules and Regulations (<https://aac.ca/en/aac-rulebook>) including, but not limited to the following:

This event will be held in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AAC. The obstacles will be chosen from those that are described in the current version of *AAC Official Rules and Regulations* and will conform to the specification within.

All dogs regardless of breed are eligible to compete providing they are at least 18 months of age (no exception), safe to be around other dogs and handlers, and in good health both mentally and physically.

**All dogs must be registered with AAC by having a Dog Identification number to compete in sanctioned trials. This may be obtained through the purchase of a Dog Identification Card; the application can be found on the AAC website (<https://aac.ca/en/Dog-ID-Registration>).**

**Competitors must have their Dog ID cards with them. Handlers are not required to show their Dog ID card at each trial entered. Only those dogs that require a measurement to compete, or dogs that have not previously attended a trial hosted by that club with a completed ID card, will be required to produce their ID cards at trials.**

All dogs are expected to be **under control at all times** (penned, kenneled, leashed, etc.), when not in the ring. Please take responsibility for your dogs, children and family. Any competitor whose dog, child or family creates a disturbance or engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the event site. There will be no refunds offered for trial fees should a handler be dismissed from the site for any reason.

## TRIAL SITE INFORMATION

### Limited Trial Entry

This Trial is limited entry based on parking availability. Parking is extremely limited on site and drivers must obey direction by facility owners. We highly recommend carpooling for teams and volunteers.

The show site is outdoors on grass and will proceed rain or shine. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, and water for your dog. A warm-up jump will be provided for all exhibitors, along with a cool-off pool for the dogs.

### Trial Site Rules

This trial is located on private property with neighbours on both sides of the trial site. As such, any dog that is nuisance barking may be asked to leave the site without refund, if they cannot settle. For dogs who are prone to barking, while watching other dogs work or walking past them, it is highly recommend crating area be chosen away from the traffic, e.g., tucked back in the grass area, back in the woods, in the car, or (if permitted by owner) in the barn.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s), and preventing them from any marking of equipment, ring, benches, and buildings. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

This is a **non-smoking** trial site, including the driveway, lawns, and structures. Smoking is only permitted inside your vehicle. No alcohol is permitted on the premises, as per the rental agreement of this Trial Site.

Toilets are available to competitors and volunteers on site. The toilet in the barn is a liquids-only toilet, i.e., absolutely zero solids permitted, including toilet paper. Any failure to uphold this rule will result in the loss of the functionality of this toilet for the remainder of the day. A bathroom is also available inside the house, just off the back door, which has a fully functional toilet.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in their crate or in the ring. Please be courteous to others using the area. **Absolutely, no aggressive dogs are permitted on site.**

### Crating

Crating space is at a premium at this trial site. Please stack crates when possible. Note, X-pens are **not** permitted at the trial site. If you have a large shade tent, please consider including other compatible teams in the shade tent. You may be asked to relocate, if the size of your tent, and/or your dogs, are disruptive to the flow of the competition, given the location of the tent. Alternatively, competitors are welcome to crate in their vehicles if weather/cooling supplies permit. **Any dogs in distress due to heat in the car will be removed from the vehicle and handlers may be excused.**

## Ring

Outdoors: 100'x100' grass-surface ring with snow fencing. Trial will proceed rain or shine. In the event of severe weather, e.g., thunder/lightning/dangerous winds, where the safety of the competitors may be at risk, the Judge, in consultation with the organizing committee, will determine if the trial should be stopped only while the severe weather is active, or if the trial should be cancelled altogether.

## EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

- All contacts are rubberized: Teeter - Galican Intercan without slats; Dog Walk - Galican Intercan with slats; and A-Frame - Galican Lite with slats.
- All single jumps are plastic, winged DoggyJumps with 5' poles.
- Double Jump is wingless (Max 2000).
- Ascending Jump is winged (Galican Intercan).
- Tire Jump is 24' salon-style breakaway (Galican).
- Flexible Tunnels include four Galican (2x10' and 2x16') and one Schauenberg (20'); all **will be** secured with tunnel bags only, i.e., **no** plates or cinches.
- Event timing will be electronic, unless there are weather or technical issues.

## BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS)

BIS will be permitted to run in this Trial. To run BIS, when their dog comes into season, competitors must immediately tell the Trial Secretary, who will mark BIS on the running orders. Furthermore, competitors with BIS should ensure they are familiar with **2.2.3 Requirements for BIS at AAC Trials**, refer to AAC's Official Rules and Regulations (<https://aac.ca/en/aac-rulebook>), pp. 11-12.

**Note: As per 2.2.3.2, Handlers should minimize exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movements about the grounds, and 2.2.3.6, A protective mat [provided by the competitor] shall be used at the start line.**

## VETERINARIAN ON CALL

We currently have a rotation of veterinarians covering out-of-hours emergency care. Should you require emergency care, please call (709) 368-3728 and follow the prompts to be connected with the clinic on call.

## PRIZES AND AWARDS

All dogs' qualifying scores will be recognized with qualifying ribbons. As well, in each Event, first to fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each height division for each of the Regular, Special and Veteran (Single and Double Drop) categories. Title ribbons will also be awarded to those who complete an AAC designated title. Additional fun prizes may be presented at the trial.

## ENTRY INFORMATION – IMPORTANT!!

- The Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc. (NADA) reserves the right to refuse entry. All competitors **must** be in good standing with the AAC.
- **Entries Open Friday, June 5, 2026 at 8:00 am and will Close Friday, July 17, 2026.**  
**\*\*No entries will be accepted after the closing date\*\***
- Reminder: This Trial is Limited Entry. The Trial will close before the posted July 17<sup>th</sup> Closing date, if the Trial fills.
- Please include all information requested on the Official Entry Form/Trial Premium (p.6). Be sure writing is legible, as this information is critical for the Trial Secretary to communicate with competitors, e.g. email them their confirmation of entries, and to report results to AAC for recording and posting purposes.
- Competitors are responsible for entering their dogs in the correct Level (Starters, Advanced or Masters) for each of the four classes (Standard, Gamblers, Snooker and Jumpers); Steeplechase is a single-level class. Competitors can track their dogs' acquired legs and titles at <https://www.aactrialresults.com/id.html>.
- Move-ups will be allowed during the Trial. Be sure to notify the Trial Secretary promptly!!
- As per AAC's rule 2.7.2.6, **senior handlers or handlers with disabilities** must indicate on the Official Entry Form (p.6) that they would like to request the Accessibility Option (Tick box to Select) to receive modified times/reduced number of points.
- To assist the Trial Secretary to track when the Trial is full, i.e., vehicle capacity at *Fun Tyme Agility & Dog Sports* reached, please indicate on the Official Entry Form/Trial Premium (p.6), whether you will be carpooling with another competitor and/or volunteer...and if so whom.
- The completed *Official Entry Form* with *NADA Participant Waiver* signed and dated, *AAC Participant Waiver & Release Form* signed and dated, and completed *Working Preferences Form*, in addition to notice of payment of entry fees must be received by the Trial Secretary, Heather Skanes ([hakanes@me.com](mailto:hakanes@me.com)) by the July 17<sup>th</sup> Entry Close for registration to be considered valid.

- Entry fees will be refunded for documented medical reasons for dogs and/or handlers, provided the Trial Secretary is informed prior to the Trial date.
- Competitors with dogs that come into season will be allowed to withdraw and will be offered a refund if they choose not to compete. Competitors must inform the Trial Secretary as soon as reasonably possible after they become aware.
