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| POLICY STATEMENT | Criteria for Honorary Membership with Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc. (NADA). |
| NOMINATION FOR HONORARY MEMBERSHIP | <p>Honorary Member is a Regular Member who has been nominated by a minimum of TWO (2) Regular Members and then approved by the membership by vote as having made a significant contribution to the advancement of dog sports in NL through their work in dog sports.</p> <p>Nominations are to be submitted to the President and Board of Directors, in writing with a letter of recommendation.</p> <p>The letter of recommendation should include accomplishment, criteria met, and reasons for nomination.</p> <p>Nominations must be submitted at least 60 days prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM). A member shall not nominate themselves.</p> |
| NOMINATION REVIEW | <p>Nominations shall be reviewed by the Board of Directors (BOD) to ensure all criteria have been met.</p> <p>Once the nomination has been reviewed and all criteria have been met, the BOD will include the nomination in the Agenda for the AGM and advise the membership accordingly.</p> |
| MULTIPLE NOMINATIONS | Only one (1) Honorary Membership may be awarded at each AGM. |
| APPROVAL BY MEMBERSHIP | <p>The nomination will be voted upon by the membership at the AGM.</p> <p>If the nomination is successful, the nominated member will have all benefits entitled to them as an Honorary Member as of the day after the AGM.</p> <p>If the successful member is a part of a Family Membership, only the nominated member will have the benefits entitled to them as an Honorary Member. The other member(s) of the Family Membership will have a separate Individual Membership or Family Membership from the Honorary Member.</p> |
